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## **What is Ventanilla de Salud?**

The Ventanilla de Salud provides immigrant and Latino families culturally appropriate health education, free health screenings, and referrals to community health services in partnership with the Consulate General of Mexico.

## **What does the program provide?**

- Free on-site medical screenings, health workshops, and enrollments into public health programs
- Assistance in navigating area health care systems
- Referrals to free area resources for health issues facing the Latino community
- Preventive health materials and education
- Outreach and education at health fairs, schools, and community events

## **What can the Ventanilla de Salud do for you?**

- Find low-cost clinics and health care providers
- Enrollment in public health programs that offer medical insurance and other types of social assistance
- Connection to free community services such as English classes, and food and clothing assistance
- Provide health related information on key topics such as diabetes, HIV, vision, prenatal care, immunizations, and more
- Find medical insurance such as Medicaid, Medicare, CHIP, etc.

## **What does the Ventanilla de Salud program NOT offer?**

- Medical consultations
- Drug prescriptions
- Ventanilla de Salud is not a clinic, health center, hospital, pharmacy or medical laboratory.
